Bio: Dr. Mouhannad Nouh has been working in academia since 1995. He currently holds the rank of Professor at Qatar University. He was formerly a faculty member at Damascus University where he served as the Head of the Public Law Department for four years and as the Director of Procurement and Financial Control for three years. He was also the Head of the Public Law Department at the Specialized Arab Encyclopedia in Damascus for four years. He actively practiced the profession attorney in Syria, and handled numerous administrative, tax, civil, and arbitration cases. He served several committees and was responsible for drafting administrative law projects in Syria. He conducted more than hundred legal training courses independently, and taught at various universities in Syria, Jordan, and Qatar. Prof Nouh authored around hundred publications, including books, in-depth research papers, and encyclopedic works. He contributed to the TEMPUS Project aimed at developing university administration in collaboration between Damascus University and the European Union, and worked as a consultant for the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) on projects for developing local administration and postal services. One of the most significant research funding he received was from the Qatar National Research Fund for a project on developing sports legislation in Qatar. Prof Nouh reviewed dozens of legal research papers for specialized legal journals and for academic promotions purposes from various Arab universities, he also supervised and participated in the defense of numerous doctoral and master's theses.
